RAPID

The <u>Rural Areas Property Identification Directory</u> (RAPID) System is being implemen in the One Tree Hill rural area. A local committee, with the task of establishing the RAPID System, has been formed. The committee has representatives from the Police, CFS, SES, St. Johns, Munno Para Council, ETSA, Rural Watch and OTH Progress.

The RAPID System is a simple universal method for identifying and locating rural properties. Each property/dwelling is identified by a name and a six digit RAPID number. The name is the map name of the appropriate map taken from the Australian 1:50,000 topographical map series. Our scheme is restricted to the Gawler, Barossa, Adelaide or Onkaparinga maps. The RAPID number is the map or grid reference for the dwelling which is read from the named map by reference to the local topographical features. A six digit grid reference, and its associated map name, is only sufficient to specify the geographical location of a dwelling to the nearest 100 meters. Because of the need to disambiguate neighbouring properties/dwellings, the system will only function in regions where property areas are significantly greater than one hectare.

For quick response, and to simplify the location of properties, each property will be supplied with a reflective sign with their grid reference, similar to a vehicle number plate, which should be prominently displayed near the property entrance. To assist property occupiers, a keytag with the property's RAPID number will also be supplied. This key-tag should be attached to the telephone handset normally used in emergencies.

Properties can be located by either reading and interpreting the appropriate topographical map, or by reading and interpreting the grid references on the reflective signs.

The system will be used by the emergency services to locate properties in times of emergencies, but it can also be used by anyone as a means of locating properties. Instead of having to furnish tradespersons, friends and relatives with elaborate directions to your own property, you will only need to provide the street name and your RAPID number. (In theory, the street name is not necessary, but it does provide some redundancy for human errors.)

The One Tree Hill scheme will be self-funding, but will seek donations from local government and community organisations. Each property involved in the scheme will be approached by CFS and RW volunteers who will explain the system, collect information for the directory and seek a tax deductable donation for the scheme.
