So too is a bottle of cleaner - metholated spirits - so that you can clean off your message when the event has passed.

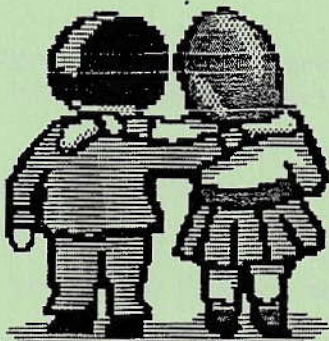

FIRE DANGER SEASON 1993/1994

MT LOFTY RANGES FIRE BAN DISTRICT

The fire danger season begins on December 1st, 1993 and ends on April 30th, 1994.

From December 1st, 1993 to December 20th, 1993 permits will be issued with C.F.S. participation.

During the period from March 16th, 1994 to April 30th, 1994 burning may be carried out provided a written permit is obtained from an authorised fire permit issuing officer. The permit will stipulate the conditions under which burning off will be permitted.

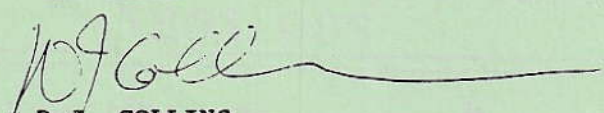

A minimum of 12 hours notice prior to requiring a permit is required.

The standard conditions that will apply to all permits for burning off are:-

1. No permits will be issued for burning on Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays.
2. Permits issued to cover a 24 hour period only, may be issued up to seven (7) days prior to burning off operations being conducted.
3. Permit holders to notify the City of Munno Para by midday of the permit issue and intention to burn.
4. Fire to be completely extinguished by 9.00 pm on the day of the permit issue and intention to burn.
5. The land immediately around the land to be burnt off must be cleared of all flammable material to a distance of at least four (4) metres.
6. A sufficient number of people to control the fire must be present at the site of the fire from the time it is lit until it is completely extinguished.
7. Neighbours and authorities must be notified in accordance with the Act and Regulations.

NEWS REVIEW SALISBURY-ELIZABETH EDITION
ON 1ST DECEMBER 1993

The change in Electoral boundaries will mean that some electors in the Elizabeth and Munno Para areas will need to go to a new polling booth at the forthcoming State Election on 11th December 1993.

In the District of Napier, residents of Hillbank now have their own polling booth. It will be located at the Anglican Community Services Centre (formerly St. Laurences) in Blamey Road, Elizabeth East.

Since Hillbank was first developed, residents have voted in other parts of Elizabeth but for this Election they should go to this new location.

Craigmore North is now in Napier and residents of that area and Blakeview can vote at the Craigmore High School on Uley Road.

The Virginia district has been divided between Napier and Taylor, so a combined polling booth will be operating in the Virginia Hall in the main street of Virginia.

At One Tree Hill the boundaries have reverted to the old Sampsons' Flat Road (now One Tree Hill road). Those people living east of this road are in the District of Kavel and will need to go to Kersbrook to vote. Residents of One Tree Hill town and area west of this road are in Napier and will be able to vote at the One Tree Hill school on McGilp Road.

The Returning Officer for Napier, Mr. Lance Hatcher, stressed that all electors should attend the booth appointed for their district thus avoiding lengthy delay at a polling booth outside their district.

FIRES FROM ANGLE GRINDERS AND WELDERS

Sparks from angle grinders, oxy cutting gear and welders used during the Fire Danger Season can cause grass fires and bushfires.

The regulations involving the use of this type of equipment during the Fire Danger Season are clear. All South Australians must be aware of their responsibility and of the dangers involved in the use of grinders, cutters and welders.

Electric welders, angle grinders, oxy cutting tools and other gas fired appliances can only be used outdoors when there is no Total Fire Ban in force. Even then there must be a four (4) metre cleared space, and the operator must have a knapsack or water extinguisher on hand.

Dampen down the surrounding area with water before you start your job and always have an observer with you when carrying out work.

Illegal use can result in fines of up to \$4,000 for a first offence.

If in doubt about operating any equipment that produces heat which may start a fire, seek advice from your local Council Fire Prevention Officer CFS Regional Office or call the CFS Hotline.
