NEWS FROM THE ONE TREE HILL PROGRESS ASSOCIATION

THE ULEY CHAPEL GRAVEYARD

At our July meeting there was some discussion about the state of this graveyard and the possibility of establishing a project to restore and beautify the area.

For those who are unfamiliar with this site, Uley Chapel Graveyard is situated on the northern side of Uley Road, about 1km from the Uley Road Scenic Route T-junction. Uley Chapel was demolished some years ago following ongoing problems with vandals. The Chapel was built in 1851 and the graveyard bears the names of many of the early pioneering families in the district.

Progress Association would like to encourage discussion on this issue with a view to establishing a community project. In particular, we would like to hear from families of people who are buried in this graveyard.

Comments can be sent to the Grapevine or pass on verbally to me and these will be published in future editions. You may like to consider different ways in which an area such as this could be restored/beautified.

The next meeting of the Progress Association will be on August 13th at 8 p.m. in the supper room of the Institute. Mr. Trevor Page will be attending this meeting to discuss environmental issues, including landscaping to the front of the Institute building. All residents are very welcome to attend.
