


Work has started on the disabled/pram crossing in the main street and we are still talking to council and DPTI on the best outcome for a limited pedestrian crossing.

# One Tree Hill CFS ~ Incident Report March 2019

Well, I guess the dream month for CFS would be to have no call-outs, we nearly achieved that in March with only one fire call, this was for a small grassfire in a paddock in Hillbank, early in the morning on the 8<sup>th</sup> of March. The cool overnight temperatures and dampness from the overnight dew helped slow the spread of the fire and it was quickly brought under control. Apart from that callout, we had an active standby for the total Fire Ban on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of March and were asked to assemble a strike team on the 3<sup>rd</sup> to head to Victoria on a 7-day deployment to help with the fires over there. Despite several eager volunteers, that team was not required and was later stood down.



The One Tree Hill CFS would like to take this opportunity to thank Bruce Hobby, who with his recent “retirement” has also decided to take a less active role in the Brigade. As President of the Brigade Management Committee, Bruce has worked tirelessly for many years now and has overseen many changes around the station over that period. Most significantly the completion of the new BA (Breathing Apparatus) room which has streamlined the stowage and cleaning of our BA equipment. Bruce has also been the Brigade social co-ordinator over that period and his Christmas parties have been a highlight each year. Bruce is not lost to the Brigade however and when he is not travelling will remain as an active firefighter.

## Fire Danger Season



Just a reminder that as of the 23<sup>rd</sup> of March, the Fire Danger Season still has a little over a month to run and is scheduled to end on the 30<sup>th</sup> of April. There is still the option for that date to change if there is not a break in this extended dry spell so it will pay to look on the CFS website if you have any doubts. A reminder also that once the rains do come, the roads tend to be extremely slippery so please take care.

Dear Fellow Ratepayers and Residents,

It has been another busy month and it seems the month has past us by in a wink.

Many people have been asking me if I am enjoying my time on council? This is an interesting question, as I didn't run to enjoy the role but to represent the community and ratepayer. However, I am relatively happy with the progress to date and will have plenty to focus on over the next four years.

This month has seen my attention focused on many community concerns and issues, some of which were planning concerns. This included an airstrip application, motorcycles on reserves, addressing concerns with the spread of Silverleaf Nightshade and the CBD development.

An issue with the Uleybury Cemetery has been brought to my attention by a local resident, highlighting some very interesting history and I plan to do further research into this. The City of Playford has agreed to assist us with some maintenance and a tidy up of the grounds.





## What's Flowering In My Garden?

It's that time of the year when flowers in the garden are scarce. There is plenty of greenery to enjoy despite the awful recent heat and lack of Summer rain. Many plants have had to be revived whilst some plants have not survived the relentless heat and dry soils. Let's hope that we receive some Autumn rains followed by decent Winter rain to recharge the depleted subsoils .

Grevillea Peaches and Cream has been flowering over Summer and into Autumn with limited extra water. The beautiful brush type flowers open as a creamy green and gradually turn to a soft yellow and as they age the flowers turn a stunning orange pink. The bees love these flowers and the New Holland Honeyeaters and Eastern Spinebills are frequent visitors , seeking the nectar that these lovely flowers have to offer. This Grevillea is a hybrid between the white flowering Grevillea banksii and Grevillea binnatifida. It is a very worthwhile garden plant that displays stiff fern like mid green foliage and will grow about 1.5m high by 2m wide. As a dense bush it offers a safe nesting place for the birds, especially the Blue Wrens and the ever present Blackbirds. This bush, being frost tolerant and being able to survive on minimal water is a prolific bearer of flowers during Spring after reasonable Winter rains.

Seek this plant from any good nursery, watch it grow quickly and eagerly await it's glorious Spring flowering display of beautiful flowers.

Grevillea Peaches and Cream. Just Beautiful.


## CONSERVATION VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITY


- Revegetation and weed control,

# One Tree Hill Area Weeds of Concern

**Caltrop (*Tribulus terrestris*)** (also called bindii, cat's head, goat's head, yellow vine) is a declared weed in South Australia under the Natural Resources Management Act 2004 (NRM Act), and it is a landholder's responsibility to control infestations found on private land. Caltrop originates from the Saharan area of North Africa, and is thought to have been introduced to Australia as a contaminant in seed.

The following sections of the NRM Act apply to Caltrop in the Adelaide and Mount Lofty Ranges region:

- 175 (2) Cannot transport the plant or anything carrying it
- 177 (1) Cannot sell the plant
- 177 (2) Cannot sell any produce / goods carrying the plant
- 182 (2) Landowner must control the plant on their land
- 185 NRM authority may recover costs for control of weeds on roadsides from adjoining landowners

Caltrop is a flat, sprawling, summer-growing, annual herb. The trailing stems of caltrop lie prostrate on the ground, radiating from a central taproot. The stems are reddish brown, wiry and covered with fine hairs.

Caltrop has small divided leaves, arranged in pairs on opposite sides of the stem. The leaves are darker on the upper surface than on the lower. Each leaflet is about 5–12 mm long and 3–5 mm wide. Fine hairs, particularly on the underside, give a silvery appearance to the leaves.

Flowers are produced from spring to autumn. Flowers are small, less than 1 cm in diameter, yellow and have five petals. The fruit of Caltrop is a woody burr with sharp rigid spines to about 6 mm long, and are produced throughout summer and autumn. The burr splits into five wedge-shaped segments when ripe with each segment containing two unequal pairs of spines. Each fruit segment contains up to four seeds. Up to 1000 fruit can be produced on each plant, with a total of up to 20,000 seeds. Seeds

germinate after summer rain. Plants grow rapidly, flowering and forming new burrs within three to five weeks. Buried seed remains viable for several years.

The burrs cause injury in urban and recreational areas, and are a hazard in horticulture. They are a hazard to stock, damaging the feet, mouth, stomach and intestines of animals. It is toxic to sheep and may present similar problems to native fauna. The burrs are well-equipped for dispersal – whichever way the fruit lies on the ground, one of the spines always points upwards. The burrs readily attach to the feet of animals, vehicle tyres, rubber-soled shoes and almost any object that is placed on it. The burrs also become embedded in sheep fleece.

Caltrop can be controlled either by physical removal or the application of a registered herbicide. The Adelaide and Mt Lofty Ranges Natural Resource Management Board has produced the video "How to Control Caltrop", which can be found at [https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=GQ0fxQA\\_bpY](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=GQ0fxQA_bpY), and covers both the spraying and physical removal of Caltrop.

Both of Fred's granddaughters were now riding and competing. On weekends the floats or horse truck would be loaded, Fred's one tonner with his show viceroy, and the whole family would head off, to either a local, regional or royal show. They were long days but very memorable.

For the past ten years Fred has donated his WW11 RAAF uniform and memorabilia for the One Tree Hill Anzac Dawn Service and is very honoured to attend the morning service along with many others.




